Candidates must hold a PhD degree, I3 Certification, International post-doctoral experience in the area of neurosciences and Leadership accreditation in projects and publications.

The successful candidate is expected to establish and consolidate an independent line of research into molecular mechanisms of neurodegeneration in Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis with a translational focus, obtaining competitive funds and collaborating with local, national and international groups. The investigator will participate in the scientific activities of the IIS, the supervision of technicians and personnel in training and contribute actively to promote scientific excellence.

Biobizkaia, is a **scientific structure** conceived as a cornerstone of the Basque Government's strategy to consolidate the Biomedical Sector in in the province of Biscay in the Basque Country (1 million of population), seeking to improve the health and life expectancy of the population.
