The successful candidate is expected to organize and coordinate the advanced therapies in Biocruces Bizkaia, support and supervising projects in the Clean Room and promote and provide assessment in new projects related obtaining competitive research funding. Besides the candidate is going to be a Group Leader Researcher with the commitment to create a new laboratory of neuro regeneration at the Institute and establish a productive and independently funded research program in these areas. Candidates must be skilled and experienced in both areas. Strong communication and organizational skills will also be important.
